☐ All doors and corridors are wide enough for wheelchairs/mobility aids/pushchairs.
☐ We have toilet facilities suitable for wheelchairs.
□ Baby changing facilities are available
☐ Of our bedrooms, 2 ground floor rooms have been built specifically for wheelchair
access and can be made up to provide single, twin-bedded or double-bedded.*
□ Please note that there is not a lift in the Inn.
□ Dogs are permitted in some parts of the Inn.
□ Provisions for dogs are provided.
□ Wi-Fi is available throughout the Inn.
☐ The inn is no smoking.
